Please note: these classes are mandatory for all members of our competitive team to ensure the safety, technical development, and continued improvement of each dancer. These classes are carefully selected to build strength, flexibility, endurance, and artistic skills which are essential for both injury prevention and competitive success. These classes provide the foundation necessary for dancers to perform at a competitive level while minimizing the risk of injury.

Rehearsal Fees (per person):

- Large Group (10+ dancers): \$30 per 5 hours of rehearsals
- Small Group (4-9 dancers): \$50 per 5 hours of rehearsals
- Duet/Trio (2-3 dancers): \$125 per 5 hours of rehearsals
- Solo (1 dancer): \$180 per 5 hours of rehearsals
- *please note the average rehearsal time for each dance is 10 hours total*
- *the total number of rehearsal hours will be at the discretion of the teacher*
- *please note that some group pieces will be mandatory for the benefit of each dancer and learning how to work as a team*

Competitive Registration Fees:

- Large Group: \$65 per competition per number
- Small Group: \$65 per competition per number
- Duet/Trio: \$80 per competition per number
- Solo: \$100 per competition per number

please note these fees are non-refundable as they are required entree fees by every competition

Additional Fees:

- Competitive jacket if not already owned (\$130.00)
- Costumes depending on rental, bought, or custom made
- Out of town teacher expenses (split among the parents hotel fees, travel, etc.)
- Additional classes (optional)

Expectations

Attendance Policy:

- All required classes and rehearsals must be attended unless there is an emergency or illness
- Excessive absences may result in removal from certain routines or reconsideration from team placement
- Dancers must arrive on time and stay for the full duration of each class
- In case of preplanned events (vacations, family events, or prior commitments) please notify the studio staff as early as possible

Dress Code:

- Dancers are expected to come prepared and dressed appropriately for each class
- Hair must be neatly pulled back and in a bun for ballet
- Proper shoes and dancewear must be worn (please see our dress code on our website)

Behaviour Expectations:

- Respect towards teammates, classmates, and staff
- No bullying, gossip, or negativity towards others will be tolerated
- Dancers must demonstrate sportsmanship no matter the results of each competition

Parent Involvement:

- Please communicate questions or concerns directly with studio staff
- Please avoid coaching or correcting dancers from the sidelines
- Foster a positive environment by respecting studio policies and supporting other dancers

Injury and Health:

Safety is our top priority. If a dancer is injured:

- Please inform the staff immediately
- Injured dancers may still expected to attend class and rehearsals to observe
- A doctor's note may be requested before allowing the dancer to return back to full participation
